Schedule/Syllabus:

Semester 1:

- Focus on History of Anglo-Saxon Countries (British Isles, USA, Commonwealth)
- Review of key periods of British History (including students own research)
- Creation and growth of USA to a superpower
- Colonisation of the Dominions and integration into the Commonwealth
- Students debate the most "popular issues"
- Students present a famous incident/personality from the period.

Semester 2:

Focus on Politico-Geographic vs. Cultural Issues in each country:

- a) Students present and prepare fact sheets on:
- Political, Geographic and historical basis of the state
- Key parts of the country's culture, education, sights, ethnic identity
- b) Mock Maturita on chosen subject.
